Playing rules

1. This tournament is played according to the current ICCF Playing Rules for individual tournament games played normally by email, and the official guidelines to these. Both documents (in English version) are enclosed to the start list of the tournament.
2. The start date is 11.4.2006, but of course you may start play as soon as you want; playing time is not counted until the start date. It is highly recommended to start the games just a few days after receiving the start list.
3. For sending of moves, the use of international numeric notation is mandatory, unless both players agree, at the outset of their game, to use a clearly defined alternative notation. The ICCF playing template must be used and continuously updated each move, with dates, as shown in the following example:

4. No result will be recorded if the moves are not sent in! It is a big help for the TD if this is done by email in PGN format. A games database will be made available to all players at the end of the tournament.
